

Medical Massage Specialists are very much in demand as the evidence-based research proves significant benefits of specialized massage for myriad of health conditions & diseases. The Opioid Crisis and substantial increase in patients with Chronic Pain, PTSD, Anxiety & Depression has elevated the status of well-qualified, better-trained and experienced massage therapists.

According to American Massage Therapy Association (AMTA) report, Massage Therapy is now a well-accepted nonpharmacological therapy for managing pain. It is recognized by the National Institute of Health (NIH), and included in nonpharmacologic pain guidelines issued by the Joint Commission, as well as the American College of Physicians (ACP), and the Federation of State Medical Boards. It is also recognized by the Department of Defense and the Veterans Health Administration as an effective treatment for chronic pain. The Attorney Generals of more than 37 states have asked Health Insurance companies to include coverage for massage therapy as an alternative to opioids.

The American Medical Massage Network (AMMN), is the only national 'Specialized Massage Therapy' organization in America, with 'Specialists' in every state. It is closely working with the hospitals, medical societies, health providers & insurance companies to recognize 'Medical Massage Specialists', referring patients to AMMN affiliates. It has also contacted CMS (Center of Medicare & Medicaid Services) to recognize & pay qualified massage therapist, to help reduce the burgeoning cost of healthcare.

AMMN, being affiliated with the Faculty of Health & Medicine of the American Academy of International Education (www.americanacademyedu.org) has introduced many programs to enhance the knowledge of medical massage, including:

- 1.
